Why collaborate?

“Conventional” approach: act only on correct legal documents

“Evolved” to:

- Promote the public interest as steward of .nl
- Position .nl as safe internet environment

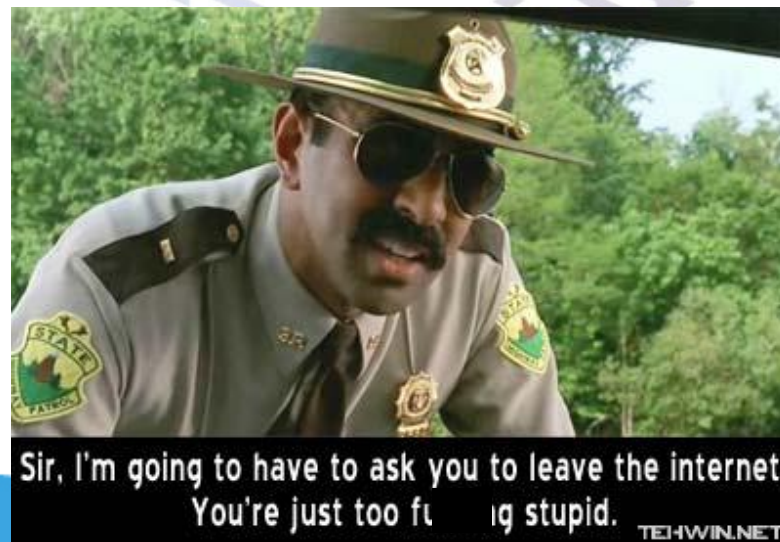


Extended access to WHOIS

- Presently, WHOIS shows all data; access non-registrars limited to 15/24hrs
- New WHOIS policy based on Data Protection Laws; limited dataset publicly accessible
- Counter: extended access (quantity and data set) for law enforcement based on contract; use restricted, what we could legally be forced to provide

Notice and Take Down

- Code of Conduct: public – private sector collaboration
- Complaint will be processed (passed on or evaluated)
- Clearly **unlawful or criminal** (rejection or action)
- ISP or eventually registry will act if content owner/-provider does not



Safe Internet Platform

- public – private sector collaboration
- “enhance safety and trust”
- set national priorities and approach (code of conduct N&TD, filtering/blocking child sexual abuse content, fight against botnets)
- implementation through working groups
